

With no-holds-barred honesty and poignant storytelling, Nate Larkin introduces a model of community and friendship that is reinvigorating mens ministry across the country, a model he calls The Samson Society. Too many men see the biblical hero Samson as their model for manhood--a rugged individualist of the highest order. Yet, Samsons solitary successes were eventually overcome by moral weaknesses. Larkin, through the

story of his own past and the stories of those in The Samson Society, offers a radical, refreshing alternative.

This book both surprised and encouraged me. A friend recommended we read this book together, so I purchased it for Kindle and didn't really know what I was getting into. The first chapter hooked me. In short, Larkin explains his history with sexual temptation, sexual addiction, and habitual moral failure, then details his attempts to overcome that temptation while still protecting his pride and hiding his shame, and how he finally found freedom (and a lot more than just that) in the company of other men who committed to know him, walk with him in his fight for purity, and love him in spite of his failures. In the end, this is a book about the miraculous power of God's grace that can only be experienced in community. Larkin's blunt honesty about his struggle with sexual temptation hit me (and hooked me) in the first chapter. He didn't gloss over his sin or use typical buzz words to blunt their true nature. It became clear to me as I continued to read that he was opening up his life in order to allow his reader to connect with and identify with his struggle. The struggles may look different, but the common themes of self-reproach, cycles of deeper and deeper addiction, the prideful need to hide shame, and the challenge of the common church's demand that people be honest (but not that honest) in their revelations about their struggles. The real gold of this book, though, comes as he explains how he has found freedom - real and lasting freedom - for the first time in his life (from the addictive patterns of sin, not the temptation to sin). And that came from honesty, a commitment to grace, and a rag-tag group of other guys who committed to walking with each other in all the gory and all the glory of the struggle. I HIGHLY recommend this book to anyone who has struggled with sexual sin and addiction and those who are walking with those who have struggled. It is filled with honesty, insight, and will light your heart up with hope.
